

# CUH & CUL UNDERCOUNTER DISHWASHER | Daily Operation & Cleaning Guide

## **DAILY START-UP:**



**BEFORE START-UP** Make sure all (6) components are clean and installed

properly in the machine. Note: See Steps 3, 4 & 6 under Daily Cleaning for assembly instructions.



**CHECK CHEMICAL BOTTLE LEVELS** 

> Make sure you have sufficient chemicals for machine operation.



CLOSE THE DOOR AND PRESS THE **POWER BUTTON** 

The power button LED light will flash until the fill process is complete. The LED light will become solid upon completion and ready to operate.



**MACHINE IS READY** WHEN THE START **BUTTON LED LIGHT** IS SOLID.

> Open the door and slide a loaded rack into the machine.



**CLOSE DOOR & PRESS** THE START BUTTON TO **BEGIN WASH CYCLE** 

> Cycle light will flash and become solid when the cycle is complete.



10 seconds of initiating cycle. "Start" and "Menu" button LED lights will flash while extended cycle is running.

**OPEN THE DOOR AND** REMOVE THE RACK

time to dry before storing.



## **DAILY CLEANING:**

**DRAIN THE** MACHINE

> Press and hold the Power/Drain Button (for 3 seconds). LED Light will flash. During draining, the display will show "drA in".



**MACHINE WILL TURN OFF AFTER DRAINING** 

SCAN TO WATCH DAILY

**CLEANING VIDEO** 

At the end of the draining cycle, the machine switches off automatically.




REMOVE UPPER AND LOWER WASH/ **RINSE ARMS** 

> Squeeze the two side buttons on the center hub; pull up (or down) to remove arm. Make sure all wash/rinse nozzles are free from obstructions to ensure proper water flow.



**REMOVE AND CLEAN ALL STRAINERS** 

> Remove any heavy food residues from strainer pans (A, B, C) and pump strainer (D).

For extended wash cycle, press Start button again within





**WIPE DOWN MACHINE INTERIOR** AND EXTERIOR WITH A DAMP CLOTH



**REPOSITION ALL STRAINERS AND WASH/RINSE ARMS** 

> Allow machine interior to air out overnight.

After installing (D), install strainer pan (B), followed by (A) and (C).



### **OPERATION** TIPS:





#### **PRE-SCRAP DISHES**

Make sure to remove large food particles and debris before loading a rack into the machine.



### **DO NOT OVERLOAD RACK**

Load only one rack per cycle, and follow proper racking guidance.



GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR CENTERLINE DISHWASHER

**USE ONLY COMMERCIAL DETERGENTS** AND SANITIZERS Do not use any other chemicals with the dishmachine.



#### **DELIME THE MACHINE**

When the Delime button LED is flashing, deliming is recommended.



#### PROPER RACKING WILL PROVIDE THE BEST CLEANING RESULTS.
